Salary: Salary is determined by experience, course credits, and enrollment. Faculty will always be paid the highest salary for which they are eligible according to the table below.

- If enrollment is 10 or higher at the end of Week 1 of the Summer Session, you will be paid according to the amounts on the attached Adjunct Salary Table.
- If enrollment is less than 10 at the end of Week 1 of the Summer Session, you will be paid the following:
 - 3-4 credit course: 2,000.00
 - 1-2 credit course: 1,000.00
