Associate of Arts/Science to Baccalaureate Degree Articulation Agreement

The College of Eastern Idaho (CEI) and Lewis-Clark State College (LCSC) enter into this articulation agreement to facilitate the transfer of the College of Eastern Idaho's AA/AS degrees to Lewis-Clark State College's baccalaureate degrees. Under the provisions of this agreement, CEI students may be granted admission to LCSC* with third year (junior) standing, contingent upon having met the conditions contained within this agreement.

*Programs such as education, nursing, and social work require additional application processes. Admission to programs with separate application processes is not guaranteed.

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to articulate the College of Eastern Idaho Associate of Arts (AA) and Associate of Science (AS) degrees with Lewis-Clark State College baccalaureate degrees.

Upon completion of the AA or AS degree at the College of Eastern Idaho, academic credit/courses taken at College of Eastern Idaho will be transferred to Lewis-Clark State College and LCSC will consider the student core certified. This agreement is intended to address the transfer of the AA/AS degree and applies only to those students who have completed and earned the AA/AS degree.

For the purposes of this agreement, the student may select any edition of the Lewis-Clark State College catalog, provided that the catalog was published and was in force while the student was enrolled at Lewis-Clark State College and/or the College of Eastern Idaho, and provided that the catalog is no older than six (6) academic years at the time of graduation from Lewis-Clark State College.

Process

- College of Eastern Idaho will provide current AA/AS degree requirements to Lewis-Clark State College and notify LCSC of any degree requirement changes.
- College of Eastern Idaho will provide advisement to College of Eastern Idaho students throughout their attendance at CEI. Lewis-Clark State College will provide pre-transfer advising at/or before the point the student attains 45 credits. Pre-transfer advising will be conducted using either official or unofficial transcripts provided to LCSC by the student.
- Lewis-Clark State College staff will be available for questions and assistance related to transfer issues along with periodic training opportunities for College of Eastern Idaho advisors.
- Lewis-Clark State College will notify College of Eastern Idaho of any degree requirement changes.
- Lewis-Clark State College will provide College of Eastern Idaho advisors and students with specific department/major pre-professional course requirements including course equivalency worksheets along with other, if applicable, department/major specific requirements.

Conditions

- Students must submit an official application to Lewis-Clark State College and provide LC with documentation (transcripts) proving successful completion of the AA/AS degree at College of Eastern Idaho.
- Completion of the AA/AS degree provides a guaranteed transfer of credit to the college but does not guarantee completion of any specific department/major requirements.
- Admission to specific areas of study/majors may be dependent upon completion of pre-professional coursework taken at College of Eastern Idaho and possibly other considerations set forth by the specific Lewis-Clark State College instructional division.
- If specific prerequisites have not been met at College of Eastern Idaho, those prerequisites may need to be met prior to being accepted into the program/major.
- Attendance at another institution after completion of their College of Eastern Idaho degree and prior to start at Lewis-Clark State College will void the provisions of this agreement.
- Students must complete a minimum total 120 credits (many majors require more) to graduate from Lewis-Clark State College with a baccalaureate degree. A minimum of 36 credits must be at the upper division level and the final 32 credits earned prior to graduation must be completed at Lewis-Clark State College.
- Non completion of the College of Eastern Idaho AA/AS degree program will void the provisions of this agreement. Students seeking admission to Lewis-Clark State College without the AA/AS degree may not benefit from the provisions of this agreement and should contact the Lewis-Clark State College admissions office for regular admissions requirements.

Renewal, Revision, Termination

This agreement is effective as of January 1, 2019, and will be reviewed for renewal every three (3) years. Either CEI or LCSC upon written notice to the other institution may request revision of this agreement. Either institution, at any time during its term, may terminate the agreement for reasons of noncompliance via written notice to the other institution. Termination notice shall not be given less than 60 days prior to the end of the current term of the agreement.


