<p>This plan outlines the specific classes at WSU that will transfer to Lewis-Clark State. If you wish to qualify for both WSU and LC State nursing programs, there are specific classes that are needed only for the WSU College of Nursing. In addition, there are three courses needed by the LC nursing program that are not required for the WSU program.</p> <p>Students must maintain a minimum Sci/Stat GPA of 2.75; this includes Chem 102, Physiology, Anatomy, Microbiology and Statistics. A minimum grade of "C" is required in each of the science classes and statistics. In addition, nursing support courses all require a minimum grade of "C". Because LC State has a competitive application, the average Sci/Stat GPA of admitted students is around a 3.4.</p> <p>LCSC's BSN applications are accepted every fall and spring via www.NursingCAS.org.
