- This advising guide is based on completion of an Associate's degree (AA/AS) in Business at the College of Western Idaho with additions made to meet lower division requirements.
- Students who transfer without being core complete may need to take additional LCSC General Education core courses.
- 32 Residency (LCSC) credits required for graduation/36 must be upper division.
- At LCSC students must earn a grade "C" or better in MATH, ECON, PSYC 101 and all required courses in the major.
- The "X" in the LCSC column indicates the class was likely transferred if student chose CWI elective.

At CWI a minimum grade of "C-" is required for Gen Ed courses and a minimum 2.0 GPA is required to qualify for Associate's Degree.
