- At LCSC students must earn a grade "C" or better in MATH, ECON, PSYC 101 and all required courses in the major.
- The "X" in the LCSC column indicates the class was likely transfered if student chose CWI elective.

At CWI a minimum grade of "C-" is required for Gen Ed courses and a minimum 2.0 GPA is required to qualify for Associate's Degree.
