Application Deadline: December 15, 2020

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Must be a new, direct transfer student to LCSC for Spring Semester 2021
- Must have an Associate Degree prior to Spring Semester 2021
- Must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average
- > Associate degree must be from a recognized accredited college other than Lewis-Clark State College
- Must be a full-time (12 or more credits), degree-seeking student
- ➤ Must have a minimum credit requirement. (60 credits)
- Must be enrolled in a Bachelor degree program
- > Students who are concurrently enrolled at LCSC are not eligible
- > Students who currently have an approved Consortium Agreement with LCSC are not eligible
- > Students who have earned dual or concurrent enrolled credits prior to high school graduation and attend the first semester after high school graduation will be considered Freshman for scholarship purposes and therefore ineligible to apply/receive Transfer Scholarships
- Preference will be given to transfer students from: North Idaho College, Community Colleges of Spokane, College of Southern Idaho, Walla Walla Community College, Treasure Valley Community College, College of Western Idaho and College of Eastern Idaho
- > Renewable per terms of contract
