- Attended Arboretum Committee last week. Discussed trees that need to be removed around campus. Also discussed creating a campus “green space” where students can decompress for mental health benefits. The Committee asked if ASLCSC would consider this as a Legacy Project.
 - This could have benefits for student mental health for any students who take advantage of the space.
 - Two ideas: One between SUB/CSL and the Williams Conference Area (potentially problematic because of sun access and concrete environment), OR one between the SUB/CSL and SAC (moving rocks and signs and creating a set “tree surrounded” space)
- Has a SAC meeting this Wednesday.
- Senator Schmidt has a Diversity Committee meeting this Friday, and the hiring committee (not usual committee) was held. The Hiring Committee wanted to work with ASLCSC to figure out ways to reach out to students about mental health and student support, etc.
