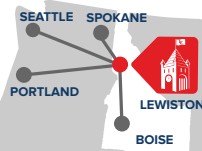

TRANSFER CREDITS & CREDIT CONVERSION

There is no cap on the number of credits a student may transfer to LC State. A minimum of 32 residential credits (at LC State) must be completed for students to earn their degree.

Quarter credits are converted to semester credits by multiplying the quarter credits by .67. *For example, five quarter credits equals 3.35 semester credits ($5 \times .67 = 3.35$).*

PRIORITY DEADLINE

MARCH 1

To ensure the greatest eligibility for federal aid and to qualify for LC State general scholarships, students must submit scholarship applications and the FAFSA by the March 1 Priority Deadline. Scholarship awards are based on academic merit, financial need, or a combination of both.



TRANSFER

SCHOLARSHIPS

Apply for a transfer student scholarship if you meet these qualifications:

- Direct transfer to LC State.
- Associate's degree from a college other than LC State.
- Plan to pursue a Bachelor's degree at LC State.
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- Plan on attending LC State full time (12 or more credits).

PRIOR LEARNING ASSESSMENT

(PLA) is a process by which you can earn college credit for learning that you have achieved through life and work experience (such as owning your own business or managing a business, training courses offered through work or the military, extended volunteerism, or independent study). Through one of the many forms of PLA, you have the opportunity to demonstrate your achievement of the learning outcomes of certain LC State courses. Not all courses are available for credit through PLA and in some cases, there are limits on how much credit you can earn through PLA.
