- This advising guide is based on completion of an Associate of Applied Science degree (AAS) at College of Southern Idaho with additions made to meet lower division requirements.
- 32 Residency (LC State) credits required for graduation.
- 36 credits must be upper division.
- To sit for the CPA exam in Idaho, you need to have 30 or more semester hours in business
- AAS General Education credits taken during the AAS may be used to partially fulfill these requirements.
- An additional 21-24 credits beyond the AAS in General Education content areas will be necessary to fulfill LC State requirements.
- Students must earn a C- in MATH, ECON, and SOC 101
- Students must earn at least a "C-" in all major courses and at least a 2.5 GPA in all business courses combined, including Accounting & Economics.
- This is just a guide. Please check with your advisor to ensure you earn at least 32 credits at LC State and have completed 36 upper division credits
