Accessibility Made Easier: Meet Canvas's New Course Checker!

We're excited to share that a course-wide Accessibility Checker is coming to Canvas! Starting March 2, instructors will see the new "Accessibility Checker" link in their course navigation menus.

Clicking this link will launch the tool, where you can follow the on-screen steps to run the checker and review any flagged items within your course. The Course Accessibility Checker is a course-level tool that enables instructors to identify, remediate, and validate accessibility issues across Canvas-created content. It streamlines accessibility compliance through live, on-demand reports, built-in remediation guidance, and content previews, making it easier to review and address accessibility across an entire course.

As you begin using the Course Accessibility Checker, we wanted to provide a heads up that it does not recognize certain fully accessible color code (CSS) used by eLearning in the creation of the course template Home page. As a result, this page will be flagged when you run the checker. If this occurs, simply click the "Fix it" button and the issue will clear without any visual changes to the page.
