Athletics/Fitness & Recreation	Intramurals	\$	10.75 Athletics	Fund used to manage all aspects of Intramurals to include leagues, tournaments, special events, and sports clubs.	Services & Supports
Athletics/Fitness & Recreation	Outdoor Recreation	\$	5.00 Movement and Sport Sciences	Funds the operation and maintenance of Outdoor Recreation to include outdoor trips (Outdoor Adventures) and rental center (Float 'N' Tote).	Services & Supports
Community Engagement	Alumni Association	\$	4.25 Office of Alumni Relations	Funds programs administered by the Office of Alumni Relations that focus on students and recent graduates. Examples include: Student Alumni (SAC) Committee, Family Weekend, AMP (Alumni Mentor Program), Homecoming, Warrior Welcome events (Lewiston and Coeur d'Alene), Senior Send Off (Lewiston and Coeur d'Alene), Warrior4Life Wednesday Events, Dinner with Warriors, sponsorship of student activities and events, partnerships with New Student Recruitment, International Programs, and Native American & Minority Services. Performing Arts	Drama / Theatre	\$	5.50 Humanities	This fee funds all of the costs associated with our yearly productions. At least one show each semester is offered. The fees help pay licensing fees, props, costumes, lighting/sound, consulting, and other production costs. LCSC students are admitted to all productions for free. Fees also help subsidize costs for Theatre student trips to the Oregon Shakespeare Festival and the Kennedy Center American Collegiate Theatre Festival each year.	Services & Supports
Performing Arts	Music	\$	4.00 Humanities	This fee funds the activities of the LCSC Choir and the LCSC Jazz Band. Both of these groups rehearse weekly during the year and put on at least one or two concerts per semester. Examples of costs include: music licensing fees, instrument repair and maintenance, venue rental, lighting/sound for performances, printing of programs & sheet music, advertising / promotion, and technical expertise and consulting. All students are admitted for free to performances.	Services & Supports

The students accept submissions, judge them, decide what to publish, market and sell the journal, do promotions, layout design, edit, manage the budget, and take care of every other aspect of running a major literary journal. The publication is partly maintained by subscriptions that are sold to libraries, universities, and individuals.</p>	Services & Supports

ASLCSC allocates a portion of its budget each year to assist with student club start up funds or fundraising matches. ASLCSC employs 11 students per year.</p>	Student Clubs/Societies
SUB/Center for Student Leadership	Student Activities	\$	28.00 Student Activities	<p>Supports student events such as the annual Welcome Fairs, where students may engage with representatives from student services, instructional programs, student organizations, and regional businesses who offer services to college students.
