**LCSC Administration Communications - Dr. Andy Hanson**

- Idaho Legislature has taken a recess due to COVID-19 outbreak
  - This means there may not be an approved higher education budget by the time the April deadline comes up
  - If it is not approved as presented, LC State will need to increase tuition as originally planned to make up for this difference (will not impact housing costs)
- Event Protocols Discussion

- Next Fall: Accreditation Review
  - One of the comments made (but not formally recommended) was that the Student Union Building was “boring” – this resulted in LC State working on reorganizing the building and promoting it as the Center for Student Leadership

- Idaho HB 339 would like to prohibit any government institution from requiring masks, which would impact school institutions. It is not expected to pass.
