On behalf of University of Utah Health, I would like to reach out to you and share information about our critical care internship opportunity for new nursing graduates. The University Hospital at University of Utah Health is a busy Level 1 Trauma Center located in the beautiful Salt Lake Valley. It's surrounded by the Wasatch and Oquirrh mountains which contain an abundance of recreational activities making Salt Lake a desirable destination for outdoor enthusiasts and those looking for adventure. The internship program is another exciting incentive to move here!

The Critical Care Internship is a 22-week program with clinical rotations through our Surgical ICU, Cardiovascular ICU, Neuro Critical Care Unit, Medical ICU, Oncologic ICU, Burn ICU and Emergency Department. In addition to clinical rotations, the interns participate in intensive didactic coursework both virtual and in-person. Upon successful completion of the program, interns are hired into one of the above mentioned units.

Applicants who have completed a capstone, preceptorship or externship in critical care or emergency medicine are preferred but not required. If accepted to the internship, a Utah nursing license is required prior to the first day of the program (unless licensed in another compact state, then 30 days is allowed).
