

Creating an FSA ID

An FSA ID gives you access to Federal Student Aid's online systems and can serve as your legal signature

- Go to studentaid.gov.
- Click on Create Account and complete (do not use your high school email).
- Verify your email and telephone number using the secure codes, which will be sent to the email address and telephone number you entered.
- Keep the FSA ID and password in a safe place. You will use these each year.
- BOTH student and parent listed on the FAFSA will need an FSA ID.
