

Helpful Hints for the LCSC Scholarship Application

- The link to the LCSC Scholarship Application is located on the Scholarship and Waivers page of the Lewis-Clark State College Financial Aid website (lsc.edu).
- Login information
 1. New students: You will use your 7-digit student ID number as your username. You will create your own password.
 2. Current Students: You will use your 7-digit student ID number and the password you previously created. If you forgot your password it can be recovered by selecting “forgot your password?” and entering your LCMail.
- Write your essay: The scholarship application requires one essay. Some scholarships require all three. Essays can be typed directly into the application or you can cut and paste from another document. Please note that scholarship committees read through hundreds of applications. Essay(s) are your chance to share content that distinguishes you from other candidates.
- ESSAY TOPICS
 1. What are three things we need to know about you in order to really understand you. Be sure to include specific details that demonstrate what you say.
 2. Pick a significant experience from your own life, no matter how small, and explain how it has influenced your personal development for the better.
 3. Describe a family, social, or school situation where you had to become a leader. How did this experience impact you?
- Depending on your major, you may need to submit additional documents for a specific scholarship. This may include letters of recommendation, writing samples or additional essays.
- Make a list of your Extra-Curricular Activities. You will type the information (name, dates involved, position held and awards) directly into the application.
 1. Clubs/Organizations
 2. Sport/Academic Teams
 3. Academic Awards/Honors
 4. Employment Experience
 5. Volunteer Experience
- New Students
 1. Must be admitted tentatively by March 1, 2022
 2. Must have a 7th semester (or 10th trimester) transcript on file
 3. Must have FAFSA completed and submitted to Lewis-Clark State College
- Current Students
 1. Must be in good standing with the Registrar’s Office
 2. Must be in good standing with the Financial Aid Office
 3. Must have FAFSA completed and submitted to Lewis-Clark State College

Your application will be saved until you submit. Once you submit your application you will not be able to update or change information. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. Application deadline MARCH 1, 2022.
