Summer III Nurse Internship: Rochester, MN

Each summer, student nurses across the United States take part in a 10 week paid Summer III experience June –August (exact dates found in job posting). During this experience employees have an opportunity to expand nursing knowledge and critical thinking skills while working under the direction of nursing professionals. Summer III's also have the opportunity to live, socialize, and work with other nursing students from across the nation.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Orientation – The Summer III experience includes a paid orientation.

Schedules – Summer IIIs will be expected to work full time (30-36hrs/wk). Opportunities for extra shifts maybe offered.

Uniforms – Summer IIIs are responsible for providing uniforms. Specific information will be provided upon hire.

Salary – Summer IIIs will earn a competitive salary on a biweekly basis.

Housing – Summer IIIs may make your own housing arrangements. Mayo Clinic may offer financial support for housing in Rochester, MN.

REQUIREMENTS

To participate in the Summer III externship candidates must have:

- Completed their Junior year of a four-year baccalaureate program in nursing, including completion of 2 semesters or 3 quarters of clinical nursing experience.
- A satisfactory academic record.
- Basic Cardiac Life Support for healthcare providers-BCLS.
- Enroll in the Minnesota Board of Nursing Internship upon program acceptance. Participants are responsible for college credit cost.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications will be accepted **November 1st—December 3rd Jobs.mayoclinic.org** search **Summer III.**

To be considered, applicants must provide the following:

- A resume highlighting educational background, cumulative GPA, employment history and volunteer activities (community or committee involvement, student nurse associations, professional organizations etc.).
- Written essay response electronically attached to the application. Essay questions will be located within the Summer III Nursing Internship job posting found on Jobs.mayoclinic.org.
- Proof of current Basic Life Support Certifications. Basic Cardiac Life Support for Healthcare Providers- BCLS certificate of course completion required and must not expire within 3 months after start date. Acceptable BCLS listed below:
 - American Heart Association (Title: BLS for Healthcare Providers).
 - Red Cross (Title: CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers and Health Care Providers or BLS for Healthcare Providers).
 - Military Training Network.
