3%: As you may have read in the news, a 3% budget holdback has been announced for Idaho state agencies. LC State intends to meet the 3% state budget reversion by pausing faculty development grants, reducing the adjunct instruction budget (which means we will expand course

- capacities in some areas), and forgoing reallocating/filling some vacant positions (which means, in some instances, staff and faculty will need to take on additional responsibilities and tasks).

- Windows 10 Computers: Microsoft will end support for Windows 10 on Oct. 14, 2025. To ensure a secure and compliant environment, ITS began upgrading college-owned computers to Windows 11 on Aug. 11. Upgrades will be completed overnight and spaced out to minimize disruption. No action is required unless you'd like to request a specific upgrade time (to do so, email helpdesk@lcsc.edu to schedule a time). If your department has machines that cannot be upgraded due to age, you'll receive additional information from your Cabinet representative. Any Windows 10 machine that has not been replaced or formally decommissioned by Oct. 1 will be

physically removed from service (IT staff will disconnect the device and take it from the office to ensure network security).
