- 3% Holdback: The Idaho Division of Financial Management announced that the 3% agency holdback of state appropriations for fiscal year 2026 will become an ongoing reduction. LC State will implement this through a continuation of the one-time reductions. These include a pause on faculty development grants, reducing the adjunct instruction budget, and eliminating delayed hire positions. While undoubtedly these reductions will impact our ability to move some initiatives forward, we remain focused on delivering our education mission and meeting Idaho's workforce needs.
