

Can you use Warrior Web Student Planning Progress to run a degree audit for a student?

Objectives—At the conclusion of this activity, participants will:

- A. Be familiar with the Student Planning Progress section of Warrior Web;
- B. Be able to determine which remaining credits and courses are required for a student to complete a degree; and
- C. Be able to navigate the following documents and webpages: [Transfer policies](#), the [Course Numbering](#) section of the LC State Catalog, and The LC State Advising Center [Guide to Understanding Student Planning Progress—Degree Audit](#).

Student Planning Progress is the primary tool used by advisors to identify student advancement toward graduation. **Progress** may appear to overlap and/or duplicate credits and courses in order to measure a variety of areas (i.e. LC State credit, upper division credit, total credit, and course requirements). The [Guide to Understanding Student Planning Progress](#) can walk you through step by step. It will be more useful to you if you have it open while you complete the survey. Using the following example and the documents listed in objective “C” above, please answer the following questions:

1. How many remaining credits does the sample student in the following example **have left to complete** to fulfill the requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology? (Hint: The answer is NOT 35. Refer to the last page of the example and the [course numbering](#) section of the LC State Catalog to find out why)
2. How many remaining general education core courses does this student have left to complete?
3. Though the student in our example earned 3 credits toward Mathematical Ways, why would the minimum credit requirement be 2.01 for this area of the general education core? (Hint: Refer to the [Guide to Understanding Student Planning Progress](#) and/or [transfer policies](#) for help with this answer)
