WHAT WILL YOU OWE?

MANY ITEMS FACTOR INTO YOUR COST OF ATTENDANCE

DIRECT COSTS (Paid to LC State)

- ▶ Tuition - This is what you will pay taking 12+ credits (full-time) each semester:

Idaho Resident: \$3,938/semester
\$7,876/academic year

Non-Resident: \$11,399/semester
\$22,789/academic year

Asotin County
Resident: \$6,228/semester
\$12,456/academic year

- ▶ Fees - Assessed based on number of credits and course type (in-person, online, or hybrid)
- ▶ Housing & Food (average on campus)**
\$6,386/semester
\$12,772/academic year

INDIRECT COSTS (External to LC State)

- ▶ Books & Supplies (average estimate)
\$2,179/semester
\$4,358/academic year
- ▶ Other costs
 - Transportation, fuel, maintenance
 - Personal, phone, medication, insurance

** Off-campus living expenses vary

WHAT ARE YOUR RESOURCES?

- ▶ **Grants** - money you do not have to pay back, (such as Pell Grant) must complete FAFSA
- ▶ **Loans** - money you have to pay back
 - Federal - must complete FAFSA
 - Parent Plus - must complete FAFSA
 - Private - from a lender
 - Personal - from family or friend
- ▶ **Scholarships** - money you do not have to pay back
 - LC State
 - Idaho State Board of Education
 - Idaho Opportunity
 - Launch
 - GEAR UP
 - Governor's Cup
 - High School
 - Community Groups
- ▶ **Veterans' Education Benefits**
- ▶ **Savings**
 - College account (e.g. 529 Plans)
 - Personal
- ▶ **Gifts** (e.g. monetary, supplies, laptop)
- ▶ **Work**
 - Current or future job
 - Workstudy - must complete FAFSA
