

MOSS Summer Residential Programs Packing List

The following is a basic gear list. Our recommendations are intended to maximize your ability to enjoy your experience.

Clothing

☐ 1 waterproof jacket ☐ 1 pr. hiking shoes or boots ☐ 1 pr. of sandals ☐ 5-6 pr. wool socks ☐ 4-6 t-shirts (synthetic is best!) ☐ 1-3 pr. Shorts (at least 1 pair of quick-dry shorts)	☐ 1-2 mid-weight long sleeve top ☐ 1-2 warm fleece or sweatshirt ☐ 1-2 pair comfortable long pants ☐ 1 Bathing suit ☐ 1 Towel ☐ Sunglasses & sun hat
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Synthetic fabrics provide more comfort than cotton when they have gotten wet due to perspiration or precipitation. Synthetic fabrics include materials such as nylon or polyester.

Toiletries

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Other Essentials

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MEDICATION: All medicine will be managed and distributed as needed by TRIO staff.

FOOD/SNACKS: TRIO will provide snacks for this trip. Students may bring their own snacks, if desired, but all food must be stored in the MOSS camp's kitchen area. Please pack individual snacks in a labeled bag or container for storage in the kitchen and let TRIO staff know.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE DISCOURAGED: Please be aware that earbuds/headphones, electronic games and phones can be used only during specified break times each afternoon except in cases of emergency (phones). Our TRIO staff and chaperones will collect all electronic devices at lights-out each night at camp to encourage best sleep, participation in field activities and overall experience at MOSS.

Where you will be:

In McCall, follow the signs for Ponderosa State Park. You will stop at the park entry gate and then proceed to MOSS (no need to pay unless you are going into the park). The first left after the visitor center sign will be for the University of Idaho- College of Natural Resources- McCall Outdoor Science School. Look for the large yellow sign with black lettering. At that point you will find yourself in the guest parking lot. Reference the map below and you will find a path leading toward the office that will have signs along the way.
