As part of this update, your computer will also be upgraded to Microsoft 365 (the latest version of Office), bringing enhanced security and compatibility with Windows 11. - Teams Phone Transition: As we prepare for our go live date (June 4), your Teams Phone number has now been assigned. You should be able to see a dial pad when you open Teams and select "Calls" on the left-hand menu. Even though we are not fully transitioned, starting today you can place outbound calls to any phone number (LC State or external) inside Teams. You will not be able to receive calls from external numbers until external routing goes live on June 4. Please test your current audio setup whether that's a headset, your webcam microphone, or your computer's built-in speakers before June 4 to be sure everything works as expected. Please see this page regarding setting up your voicemail and other helpful information about this transition. To give everyone enough time to decide on the right equipment, IT has extended the deadline for IT-funded headset, handset, or busy-light orders to Sept. 30, 2025. If you have a private office, you may find that using the Teams app with your existing camera, speakers, and microphone is adequate, but you can submit the order form previously supplied to

department heads whenever you are ready.
