- Microsoft Intune: The IT department is enrolling all college-owned computers in Microsoft Intune. All new computers purchased within the last year have already been enrolled. Now it's time to enroll the remaining devices. As part of this update, your computer will also be upgraded to Microsoft 365 (the latest version of Office), bringing enhanced security and compatibility with Windows 11. - Open Enrollment: Open Enrollment for 2025-2026 benefit election (including annual FSA renewal) runs April 28- May 16 (no late applications will be approved)! This is your annual opportunity to review and make changes to your benefit elections for the upcoming plan year. These sessions will cover important benefit updates, enrollment steps, and provide hands-on support to ensure your selections are completed smoothly. Also, please remember to assess your headset needs. If you want to try Teams Phone with your current device prior to making a headset or handset selection, IT encourages you to do so. Headset/handset/busy light orders can be submitted to IT via the order form previously supplied to departments.
