WHEREAS, Intimate partner violence is most common against college-aged women between the ages of 18-24;

WHEREAS, Domestic Violence Awareness Month provides an excellent opportunity for our campus to learn more about preventing domestic violence, bystander intervention, and to show support for the local organizations and Lewis-Clark State College faculty and staff providing critical advocacy, services, and assistance to its survivors;
