
Where you will be:

In McCall, follow the signs for Ponderosa State Park. You will stop at the park entry gate and then proceed to MOSS (no need to pay unless you are going into the park). The first left after the visitor center sign will be for the University of Idaho- College of Natural Resources- McCall Outdoor Science School. Look for the large yellow sign with black lettering.
