Bulletin Board Policy:

LC State updated [Policy 4.114, The Use of LC State Campus Spaces](#). This policy includes the use of campus bulletin boards. Campus bulletin boards are intended to promote campus events, programs, and services. They are accessible to faculty, staff, and students. The bulletin board in the Student Union Building/Center for Student Leadership is considered a public bulletin board and is available to the campus community and the general public. Material on all bulletin boards will be removed periodically regardless of content or origin. Guidance is posted near each campus bulletin board to assist in providing clarity on how these boards are managed.

The Center for Teaching & Learning is partnering with eLearning Services this semester to offer open lab hours. On alternating Thursdays from 12-1 p.m. beginning Sept. 10, bring your laptop or just your questions about Canvas, Panopto, online tools, instructional design, etc., to the CTL (MLH 320). Moving Parts:

- Construction Continues: Please be patient. The bulk of the various and numerous construction projects underway are subject to state funding expenditure deadlines and timelines overseen by the Idaho Department of Public Works (DPW). We are incredibly grateful for the state's support in making these projects possible, and while every effort is made to complete as much work as possible over the summer, there is no way to avoid construction commotion moving into the fall. Potential classroom disruption is being coordinated through VPs Hanson and Jones, working closely with the Registrar's Office; impacted faculty, staff and department leadership (e.g., division/department heads, deans, etc.); Physical Plant; and the state of Idaho contractors conducting the work. Some classes are being moved, at least temporarily.
