

Helpful Hints for the LC State Scholarship Application

- The direct link to the LC State Scholarship Application is located on the Scholarship and Waivers page of the Lewis-Clark State College Financial Aid website (lcsc.edu/financial-aid).
- Login information: Access the LC State Scholarship Portal through the WarriorHub.
- Write your essay: The scholarship application **requires** one essay. Your essay can be typed directly into the application or you can cut and paste from another document.
 - a. Be sure to include specific details that support your response.
 - b. Have your essay reviewed by a peer, a mentor, or the LC State Writing Center prior to submitting your application.

ESSAY TOPIC

If you had the chance to have a 30-minute conversation with any person in human history (either living or deceased), who would that person be? Why? What topics would you discuss with this person?

- Depending on your major, you may need to submit additional documents for a specific scholarship. This may include letters of recommendation, writing samples or additional essays.
- Make a list of your Extra-Curricular Activities. You will type the information (name, dates involved, position held and awards) directly into the application.
 1. Clubs/Organizations
 2. Sport/Academic Teams
 3. Academic Awards/Honors
 4. Employment Experience
 5. Volunteer Experience
- New Students
 1. Must be admitted tentatively by March 1
 2. Must have a 7th semester (or 10th trimester) transcript on file
 3. Must have FAFSA completed and submitted to Lewis-Clark State College
- Current Students
 1. Must be in good standing with the Registrar's Office
 2. Must be in good standing with the Financial Aid Office
 3. Must have FAFSA completed and submitted to Lewis-Clark State College

Your application will be saved until you submit. Once you submit your application you will not be able to update or change information. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
