- Teams Phone Updates:
  - Calling a Department on Teams: To reach a department, dial its published extension instead of searching for the department name in the Teams address book. If you do not know the extension, utilize the online campus directory. Teams Phone numbers are assigned to users' email accounts and not department email accounts as that would have required an additional cost per department account. For example, if you need to call the Helpdesk, dial 2231 instead of searching for "Helpdesk". When you search Helpdesk in Teams, it will present the department email account for the Helpdesk which does not have a number assigned to it.
  - Desktop Phones: IT has visited all offices on campus and believes it has picked up all
    the desktop phones. If any were missed, please send an email
    to helpdesk@lcsc.edu with the location of the phone and it will be retrieved.
- University Name Change: For frequently asked questions, information, and ongoing updates

- Vehicle Use Agreements (VUAs): State of Idaho Policy requires annual signing of VUAs, driver background checks, and Safe Driver Training. LC State's Policy 4.112 "Use of College Owned and College Rented Vehicles" is in the process of being updated to match these requirements. If you drive LC State owned or leased vehicles, you may be receiving a notification from Public Safety if it has been more than a year since you last signed your VUA.
