Dear all,

What a terrific May we had! Ranging from history-making commencement celebrations in Orofino, Pocatello, Kuna and Lewiston, to track, course and field successes, it has been a great time to be a Warrior!

During the 2026 NAIA Outdoor Track and Field National Championships in Asheville, N.C. Madigan Kelly, broke her own school record in the 100m hurdles, and earned her third All-American honor with a fourth-place finish. The men's 4x400m relay team broke a school record, Trenton Johnson wrapped up his career finishing 15th in the triple jump, Perry Severijnse earned an All-American finish in the javelin (7th place), the men's 4x100m set the school record, and Camille Ussher (800m), Dawson Welliver (5000m racewalk), Grace Tiegs (1500m) and Kobe Wessels (1500m) also competed.

History was made at the Lewiston Golf & Country Club with the men's team capturing the Cascade Conference (CCC) Tournament Championship. The win earned the team an automatic bid to the NAIA National Championship, where it came in 26th. Based on their play, the women earned an at-large bid to the national tournament, which took place in Ypsilanti, Mich. While there, Giulia Belfontali aced a par-3 with a hole-in-one, and the team finished 15th, its highest national finish since 2014.

After winning both the CCC regular season title and championship tournament, followed by an NAIA Opening Round tournament victory, Warrior baseball was back. Despite an opening night loss to Tennessee Wesleyan University (which went on to win the title), the Warriors finished their Series return with a show-stopping win over Georgia Gwinnett, and a gritty near-comeback against Taylor University (the national title runner-up); playing with pride, purpose, and passion.

Even with weather interruptions, the 2026 Avista NAIA World Series was a terrific success – showcasing the best of our community and campus. The time, energy, and commitment of our athletics staff; the Sodexo crew; our title sponsor Avista; major sponsors Happy Day, Joe Hall Ford, P1FCU, Guardian Plumbing, Heating & AC, and SJRMC; event and game day sponsors as well as our honorary coaches; our many regional business and industry partners; and the 400-plus volunteers (students, faculty, staff, and community members) who make the event possible were nothing short of extraordinary. Thank you, and thank you, and thank you!

### **Server Maintenance (June 8-26):**

Information Technology Services will be performing maintenance on the campus server infrastructure from Monday, June 8, through Friday, June 26. As part of this work, it will be migrating over 60 virtual servers to a new platform. Maintenance windows will take place between 6-7 a.m. on select mornings throughout this period. Not all systems will be affected on the same day, and ITS will work to minimize disruption to campus operations. The following systems may experience brief outages during this time: AceWare/AceWeb, Pharos (printing and library system), VPN, Instant ID (card system), Colleague/WarriorWeb, Johnson Controls (HVAC), and Salto (will not affect ability to use fob but won't update access during the outage window). Email and Microsoft Teams will not be affected by this maintenance.
