- This advising guide is based on completion of an Associate of Applied Science degree (AAS) at College of Eastern Idaho with additions made to meet lower division requirements.
- 32 Residency (LC State) credits required for graduation.
- 36 credits must be upper division.
- Students must earn a C- in MATH, ECON, and PSYC 101
- Students must earn at least a C- in all major classes.
- AAS General Education credits taken during the AAS may be used to partially fulfill these requirements.
- An additional 21-24 credits beyond the AAS in General Education content areas will be necessary to fulfill LC State requirements.
- Students must earn at least a 2.5 GPA in all business courses combined, including Accounting & Economics.
