

Preparation for Classic Quizzes to New Quizzes

Classic Quizzes will begin being phased out and eLearning Services wants to provide the best information for faculty to begin the process of transferring Classic Quizzes to New Quizzes. New Quizzes will be the only quiz platform starting in fall 2025.

Faculty can best prepare themselves for the transition from Classic Quizzes to New Quizzes by:

1. Creating New Quizzes from this point forward in your Canvas courses.
2. Migrating Classic Quizzes to New Quizzes if the Classic Quizzes doesn't utilize Question Banks.
3. Contact your Instructional Designer to begin the process of transferring Question Banks to Item Banks.

Syllabus Template for LC State Courses

The Office of the Provost has initiated the use of a syllabus template for all LC State courses, effective fall 2025.

The State of Idaho requires higher ed institutions to provide an AI Statement, consumer information (NC-SARA), and a statement regarding student's academic freedom. The template provides consistent, institution-approved language for these items, and also allows faculty to add course-specific information and policies to their syllabi.



Classes for Fall 2025 in Canvas

In preparation for the fall 2025 academic semester, your Canvas courses will be posted on your Dashboard this month. These courses will be located under the 'Unpublished' list of courses on your Dashboard.

When building out your fall 2025 courses, please remember the following:

1. New Quizzes will be the only quiz platform available in Canvas for fall 25.
2. Add/edit alt text for links and images to ensure they are accessible for all learners.
3. Add Word documents whenever possible and when using PDFs, reach out to your Instructional Designer to get those documents remediated.
4. When creating new video content, we recommend faculty to use Panopto.

Lastly, if you are needing content from another instructor's course imported into your fall 25 course shell, please ask for permission by emailing your Division Chair and CC your Instructional Designer in that email to help with the content importing process.

eLearning Services is Available During Spring Break



Updating Respondus LockDown Browser in Canvas

Respondus LockDown Browser in Canvas updated early this February. With these updates, you and your students may get notifications that LockDown Browser cannot complete the testing request. To override this error, you will:

1. Log into Canvas and click into the course title that has the quiz you need to fix
2. Click on 'LockDown Browser' located in the left-hand course menu bar
3. Once you click into that tab, Canvas will automatically update LockDown Browser and the quizzes will function properly again.



**Students may need to uninstall Respondus LockDown Browser and reinstall the latest version if they receive an error message when attempting to take a Respondus LockDown Browser exam.
