Library Budget Update

Catalog Migration (Spring/Summer 2025)- Ex libris to Folio - Jennifer Cromer

The library catalog migrated from Ex libris Alma/Primo June 2025 – to Folio (EBSCOhost)

Proxy Server Changes - Jennifer Cromer

The library is moving from an internally hosted EZproxy server to EZproxy hosted by OCLC.
