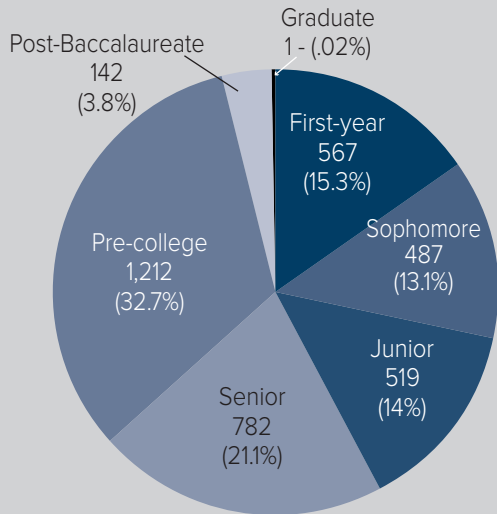


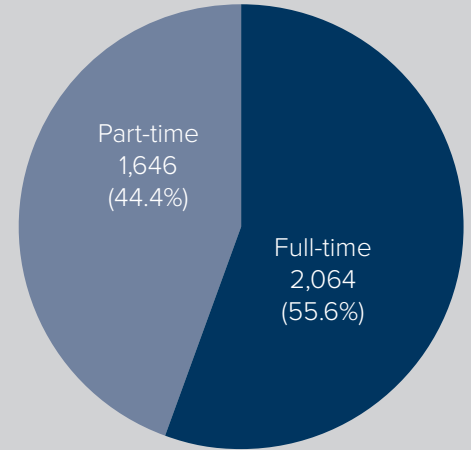
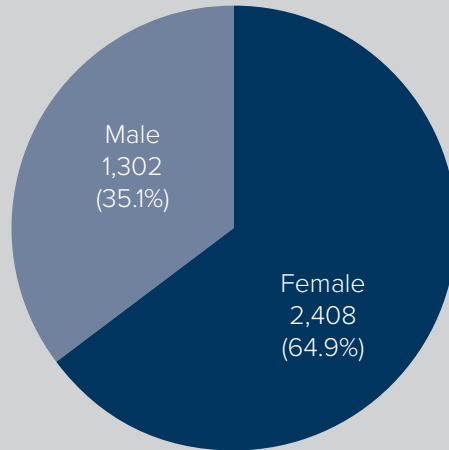

Fall 2021 Enrollment

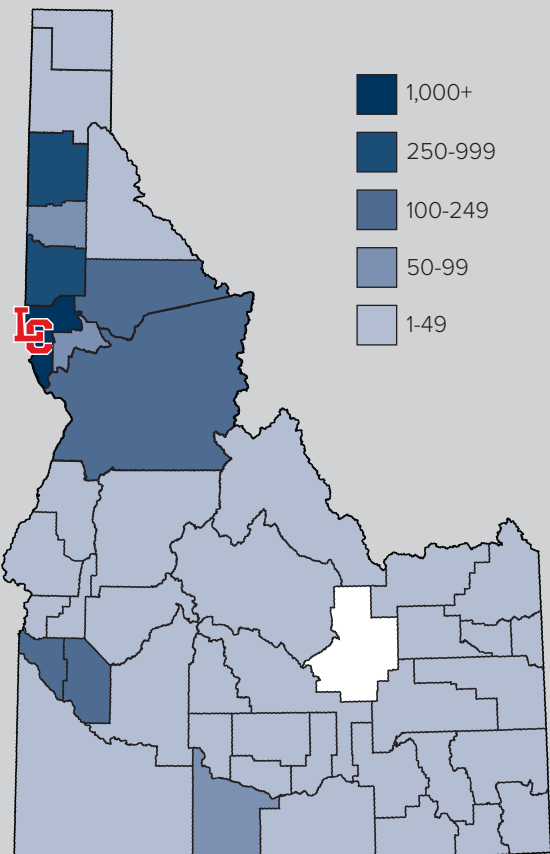
