  A minimum cumulative GAP of 3.0 is required for admission into the Secondary Teacher Education program
  Students who transfer without being core complete may need to take additional LC State General Education core courses.

• 32 Residency (LC State) credits required for graduation/36 must be upper division.

Notes:

At CEI a minimum grade of "C-" is required for Gen Ed courses and a minimum 2.0 GPA is required to qualify for Associate's Degree.
