Complete all required/elective coursework for the AA/AS degree at the College of Eastern Idaho.

- This advising guide is based on completion of an Associate's (AA/AS) at College of Eastern Idaho with additions made to meet lower division requirements.
- No grade lower than a B- will be accepted in any 300 or 400 level education courses in Secondart Education programs
- A minimum cumulative GAP of 3.0 is required for admission into the Secondary Teacher Education program
- Students who transfer without being core complete may need to take additional LC State General Education core courses.
- 32 Residency (LC State) credits required for graduation/36 must be upper division.

At CEI a minimum grade of "C-" is required for Gen Ed courses and a minimum 2.0 GPA is required to qualify for Associate's Degree.
