Speaking of staying abreast of campus happenings, after an extensive national search (with over 90 applicants, nine virtual interviews, and three on-campus interviews with finalists), Mr. Jim Klemann, current athletic director at Rocky Mountain College, will be joining us as athletic director for Warrior athletics.

Klemann has been athletic director at Rocky Mountain, in Billings, Montana, since 2021, where he oversees a nationally competitive athletic department consisting of 15 programs, 430 student-athletes, and 35 coaches and support staff. Prior to this he served at the University of Jamestown, in Jamestown, North Dakota, from 2007-2021 in a variety of roles including assistant athletic director, director of annual giving, director of transfer admissions, and assistant baseball coach/athletic game manager. Jim's experience and success as an athletic director at a small NAIA school in the northwest that competes in the Frontier and Cascade Collegiate Conferences will help him hit the ground running.

The search committee included representation from the community, athletic department, coaching staff, and from across campus. I thank the committee, campus, and community for helping achieve a very thoughtful and thorough process, and successful outcome.
