Syllabus Template

Carrying over from spring, there is now an official LC State syllabus template. You can access the template on the [Academic Affairs Information for Faculty page](#). Please note that a section was added to the Shared College Information after July 1. If you started to convert your template prior to that date, you'll want to be sure to add the "State Law, Academic Freedom, and Course Expectations" section, as it is required by the ISBOE.

Classic to New Quizzes

Canvas is discontinuing use of Classic Quizzes soon; thus, you can no longer create a quiz in Canvas using the Classic Quiz platform. You need to migrate your Classic Quizzes to New Quizzes and start creating any new quiz in the New Quiz platform. If you have questions about this migration, please reach out to your Instructional Designer.

Panopto

Last year, eLearning rolled out Panopto! Panopto offers tools for recording, editing, and distributing videos, and integrates with Canvas. Using Panopto helps with video retention and accessibility features, thus eLearning recommends migrating your instructor-created videos that you have stored in YouTube to Panopto.
