We are here all of Spring Break and summer to help with course copies, a fresh design facelift for your content, help transitioning from YouTube to Panopto, or any other Canvas course needs!


The best way to get help from your ID is to schedule an appointment! We can meet inoffice or via Teams for your convenience. Book back to back if you need more than 30 minutes.




No Foolin', Discussions are Back!

Instructure received feedback on their recent changes to Discussion Boards in Canvas Speedgrader and have stepped back some of their recent updates! When faculty grade student's discussion posts, whether you use Checkpoints or not, the grading interface, by default, has reverted back to what it used to be prior to the update.



If you enjoyed the updated Speedgrader interface for Discussion Boards, click on the 'switch to viewing the full discussion context' link located at the top. After clicking on that link, the grading window will refresh and show the student's discussion posts and replies in context of the Discussion Board. To toggle from the 'Context View' to 'Individual Posts View,' click on the 'Switch to individual posts' link in the upper right corner next to the grading panel.
