- **Microsoft Intune:** The IT department is enrolling all college-owned computers in Microsoft Intune. All new computers purchased within the last year have already been enrolled. Now it's time to enroll the remaining devices. As part of this update, your computer will also be upgraded to Microsoft 365 (the latest version of Office), bringing enhanced security and compatibility with Windows 11. - **Open Enrollment:** Open Enrollment for 2025-2026 benefit election (including annual FSA renewal) runs until May 16 (no late applications will be approved)! This is your annual opportunity to review and make changes to your benefit elections for the upcoming plan year. To help you prepare, a series of Informational Sessions and Drop-In Workshops have been scheduled with Human Resources. These sessions will cover important benefit updates, enrollment steps, and provide hands-on support to ensure your selections are completed smoothly. - **Summer Hours:** Summer hours will be in effect May 12-Aug. 1. Please see the Intranet for details.
- **Teams Phone Transition:** Due to a delay with its Teams Phone provider, LC State's transition timeline has been pushed back from the original goal of spring break to June 4. Transition details will be sent in a future message. In the meantime, please make sure to remove the 1-800 numbers from all webpages and printed materials as these numbers will not work after our transition to Teams Phone. The IT department appreciates the 186 participants who joined the Teams Phone Training sessions with Jared from CompuNet in March. If you missed training, or want to review the Teams Phone settings and functions, IT has posted a recording on the [IT department intranet SharePoint](#) along with other informational resources for Teams Phone. Also, please remember to assess your [headset needs](#). If you want to try Teams Phone with your current device prior to making a headset or handset selection, IT encourages you to do so. Headset/handset/[busy light](#) orders can be submitted to IT via the order form previously supplied to departments.
- **Tuition & Fees:** The Idaho State Board of Education approved a 3.5% tuition and fee increase at each of Idaho's four-year year institutions for the coming academic year on Friday ([new release](#)). LC State's full-time resident undergraduate tuition and fees in 2025-26 will be \$7,876. LC State's sisters will be as follows: Idaho State University \$8,914, Boise State University \$9,364, and the University of Idaho \$9,400.
- **Volunteer for the World Series:** The 2025 Avista NAIA World Series is May 23-31 and volunteers are needed to take tickets, sell programs, and help in the concession stands. With supervisor approval, LC State employees can volunteer for up to eight hours, for a maximum of
